The RYTA online project Platform

The RYTA platform allows policy makers and active citizens of the rural areas of five project participating countries (Greece, Italy, Lebanon, Jordan, and Tunisia) to be brought together, albeit virtually.

The RYTA Platform can be reached via the URL platform.rytaspace.eu.

The Platform allows access to training courses in *four different languages* (English, Arabic, Greek and Italian) through the Moodle e-learning platform.

Moodle is an open-source LMS (*Learning Management System*) used worldwide for blended learning, distance education, flipped classroom and other online learning projects in schools, universities, workplaces, and other sectors.

The platform also allows the creation of *e-meetings* through videoconferencing platforms, such as Zoom.

Using videoconferencing tools, it is also possible to make young people talk to each other via the "*E-youth councils*" section of the platform.

Thematic forums - regulated by a moderator - have been activated.

Finally, it is possible for administrator users to upload documents, folders and subfolders in the so-called *Repository*. Through the repository, the actors of the RYTA project will be able to access the digital resources made available to them.











Language localization

English home page




Hellenic home page

Over 100 language packs are available for an administrator to install on Moodle site in 'Language packs' in the Site administration, so that the RYTA administrators can work in their own language and not only in English.

- the list of the courses available in 4 languages.




Slider #1 – The RYTA partnership










Slider #2 – Invite to join e-Meeting



Slider #3 – Invite to enroll Courses








Courses

- Active Citizenship








The course title is displayed in the platform. The content of each course is ready and available for upload in the platform.

For each course it is possible to insert **LO** (**Learning Objects**) such as teaching resources (text, Power Point presentations, video, audio, etc.) and **quizzes** to verify learning.







For each course is possible to view, insert, modify and eventually delete **participants**:










Platform administration

Administrators can log on to the platform and manage **general settings** such as notifications, registration, advanced features, language settings and customisation, security, users, courses, and grades etc.



Site administration

Administrators can manage the **appearance** of the site in terms of logos, html settings, and menu items.

Menu items can be edited in **multi-language mode** (English, Hellenic, Italian and Arabic)

It is possible to create a **slide show** of up to twelve slides for you to promote important elements of the platform.

The show is **responsive** where image height is set according to screen size.

It is also possible to **enable automatic scrolling of slides** after the page loads so that homepage slider will automatically transition between slides without requiring user input or interaction.




Home page slider administration

Both the **footer** as well as all other parts of the platform has been **translated** into the 4 project languages and is editable quite easily.










Training courses of special importance can be **promoted** trough the "Promoted Courses" section of the template chosen for the platform.



Promoted Courses administration








Plugins

Plugin administration









Repository

A repository section was created within which to place both public **folders** and folders, with sub-folders and files. This repository is reserved for registered users.

Within the Repository, it is possible to create folders, subfolders and upload files.

It is also possible to **restrict** access.

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Repository access restriction








Administrators can prevent access to folders and files until or from a **specified date and time** or require student to achieve a **specified grade** o use a **certain language**.

Control access con also be based on fields within the student's profile or add a set of **nested restriction** to apply **complex logic**.



Add access restriction








Forum

A forum section is available on the project platform for all users. The forum module enables participants to have **asynchronous discussions** i.e. discussions that take place over an extended period of time.

There are several forum types to choose from, such as a standard forum where anyone can start a new discussion at any time, a forum where each user/student can post exactly one discussion, or a question-and-answer forum where user must first post before being able to view other posts.

Forums have many uses, such as:

- A social space for RYTA users to get to know each other.
- For course announcements (using a news forum with forced subscription)
- For discussing course content or reading materials
- For continuing online an issue raised previously in a face-to-face session
- A one-on-one support area for private citizen-policy makers communications (using a forum with separate groups and with one student per group)



Technical Specification

RYTA platform is built with Moodle and under the framework of e-learning standards, such as **SCORM 1.2**, **AICC HACP** standard for **CMI** and **Learning Tools Interoperability (LTI)**, that are standard ways of integrating rich learning applications with educational platforms.







Road Map

The next steps will be to build on the design we have already carried out with our project partners (PPs) and upload the learning materials into the platform in different languages. Indeed, at present the PPs are elaborating the learning materials based on Courses Outlines that have been already discussed within the consortium.

These materials will then be translated into the 4 project languages by all PPs.
